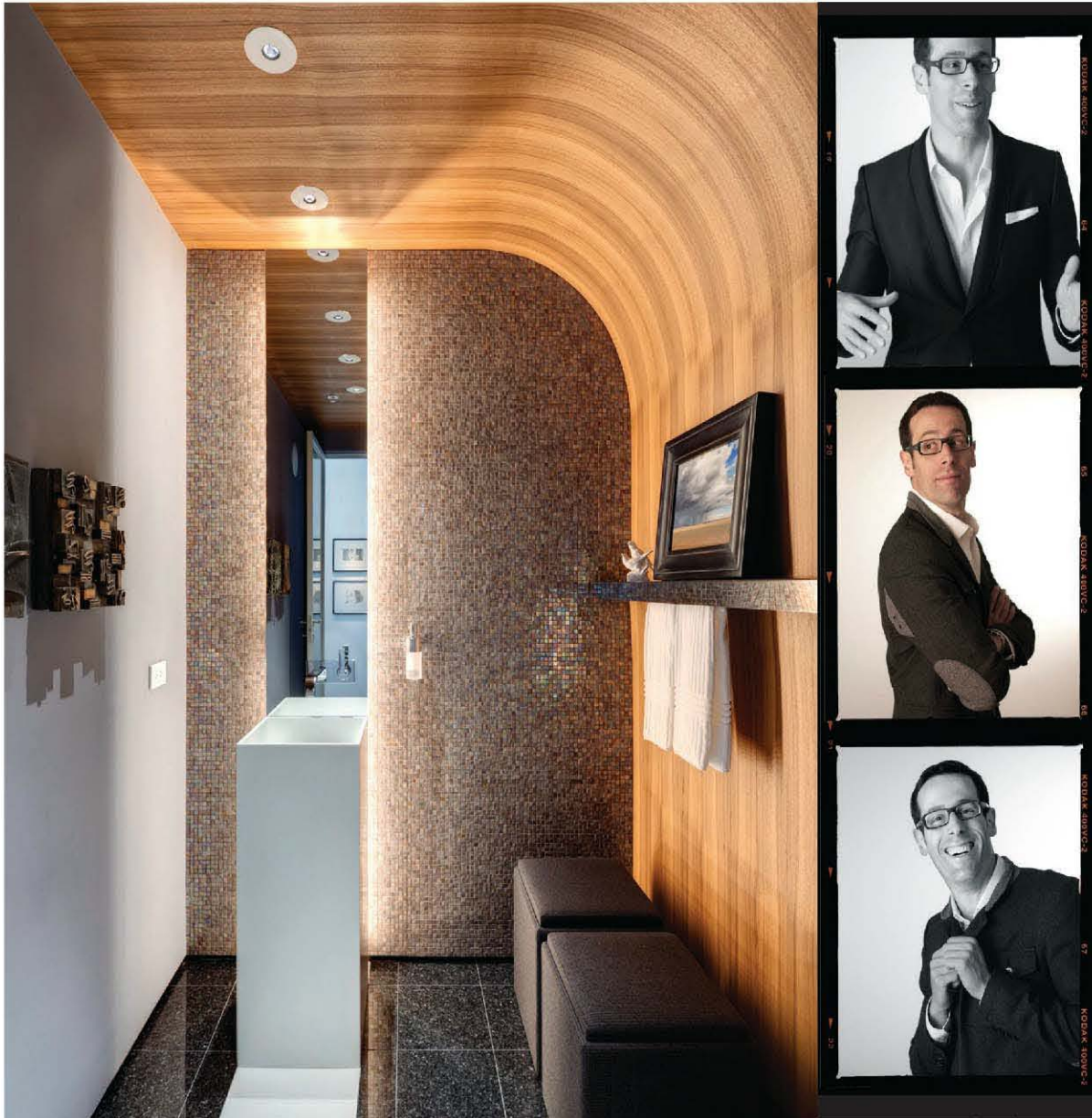

Bathroom: **Richman Interiors**

Michael Richman had to go digging in his own dumpster when it came time to design the Montgomery building master bathroom (above)—the final phase of a full-scope condo build-out. “There was a reference to the work of Donald Judd for the design earlier on for the hearth,” Richman explains. “I looked at some rejected fireplace drawings and started sketching the bathroom.” The founder of Richman Interiors is an architect by trade, and after study stints in Barcelona and Paris and employment at Holabird & Root, he started his own firm in 1998. With his trade acumen, Richman fully admits to being a details guy: “The extension of the Corian sink across the floor, the sparkling aubergine glass mosaic tile, the curved wall with the teak wood all the way around... it certainly wasn’t an easy room to do. But it has this ethereal glow to it—it’s a jewel box.”
